

**REACH – Compliance of LEONI-Studer AG with the REACH Directive EC 1907/2006**

Dear Sir or Madam,

In response to your enquiry regarding our compliance with REACH, we would like to advise you that to the best of our current knowledge:

- 1) LEONI-Studer AG supplies only articles as defined in REACH Article 3.3
- 2) Our products do not contain any substances that are to be intentionally released under conditions of use (Intended Release, Art. 7.1 of the REACH directive)
- 3) Our products do not contain any of the substances of very high concern (SVHC) in quantities more than 0.1 percent by the weight (Art 7.2 of the REACH directive)  
(Candidate List SVHC published by ECHA on 13.1.2010)

As such these products are not required to be registered, nor is notification of the substances in the article required.

As a downstream user, we can confirm to you that we are engaged in a thorough exchange of information with our suppliers and shall fulfil any registration obligations under the REACH directive. We likewise examine our products for hazardous substances that are included in the actual candidate list and the substances that will be included in Appendix XIV in the future.

Should there be changes within the REACH transition periods, which currently range between 3.5 and 11 years, in the substances and preparations that we use that would affect the property profile of our products or entail new obligations to provide information, we shall advise you accordingly and without delay.
