To Whom It May Concern:

Thank you for your interest in Fluke Electronics products and their compliance to REACH.

Fluke Electronics products are classified as articles which are not intended to release substances under normal or foreseeable conditions of use. As such, we are not directly required to register the materials used in their manufacture. However, we do recognize that the REACH regulation requires us to communicate with our supply chain in order to ensure the products we ultimately build and sell are compliant and to notify our customers where Substances of Very High Concern candidates (SVHC, as listed in REACH Annex XIV) are present above 0.1% per article.


Fluke Electronics requires our suppliers to inform us if any of the parts or materials they provide contain any REACH SVHCs above 0.1% w/w. In addition, Fluke requires our suppliers to keep up to date on the new substance additions to the REACH SVHC list and inform us promptly if there is a change in a part or materials REACH SVHC declaration status.

To this date, we have no REACH SVHC declarations above 0.1% w/w to report.

We will continue working with our direct suppliers to ensure that they understand their obligations under REACH and provide timely information sufficient to enable us to properly communicate SVHC information to our customers. We will provide updated information should we become aware of any changes.
